-The name CANDORA stands for CAN DO in Rundle and Abbottsfield.

Who are Candora?

- They are a group that works with people in North East Edmonton.
- They try to create a positive environment for families to live and grow.
- They talk about concerns in the communities.
- Candora sees people's strengths, visions, wisdom, energy, and kindness and works together to create a great place to live.

What can Candora do for you?

- Candora has a lot of resources and programs to help you with what you need, like where to go for things like housing.
- You can talk to a support worker about issues that you may need help with. Candora is a team of "supporters not doers".
- They have groups for people to go and talk, share ideas, learn and listen to other people, like the Seniors Group on Thursday, and the Multicultural Women's Group two Saturdays a month.
